## Sears Canada Advised of a Potential Safety Hazard Relating to Graco Harmony™ High Chairs.

*Toronto, ON* - March 18, 2010 - Sears Canada Inc. has been advised by Elfe Juvenile Products of a potential safety hazard relating to Graco Harmony™ High Chairs. It has been discovered that the screws holding the front legs of the high chair may loosen and fall out and /or the plastic bracket on the rear legs may crack causing the high chair to become unstable and tip over posing a fall hazard for children.

Some of the affected high chairs were sold at Sears Canada retail stores, online at [www.sears.ca](http://www.sears.ca) and through the Sears Canada catalogue between December 2003 and March 2010. The Sears regular selling price was \$79.99 – \$179.99. The affected model numbers and corresponding Sears item numbers are as follows:
